



Each unit has two projecting bays with two angled windows on each story and which flank center entries.

Voussoirs are picked out in first through third story lintels while continuous limestone bands at lintel level are in the two top most stories. Rough finish brick bands of two brick width run across the top story and beneath the denticulated cornice.
