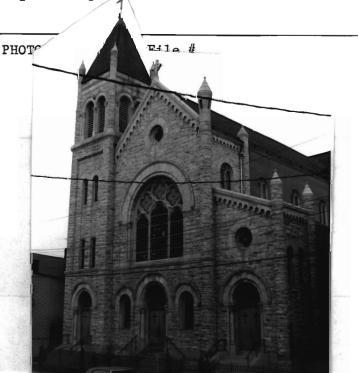

In 1874, property acquired at 61 Monroe Street, where church now stands. By this point, sermons were being preached in English, German and Italian.
