





Exceptionally fine level of masonry and wood detail is evident in these buildings. The largely residential blocks are characterized by corner shops, many of which still exist. This area was included in the original tracts of the Hoboken Land and Improvement Company, founded by the Stevens family in 1838. Willow/Clinton Aves. formed the western dividing line between the higher ground and former salt marsh. This block remained rural well into the 1880's. development of the land coincided with the increased numbers of immigrants whosettled in Hoboken at that time. Restrictions imposed by the H.L. & I. Co. mandating that new construction be of brick or stone and at least 3 stories high, provided these sturdy and attractive residences.

Six, five-storey brick buildings, four bays wide, with Italianate detail. Intact cornices at #800-808. #800 also retains a corner storefront, with a central entry on Willow Ave. Five steps lead up to the main residential entries. These buildings also feature stone water tables and footed, Italianate window sills.

812 Willow Ave., vacant lot.

Eclectic, five-storey brick building with four bays, divided vertically. Pedimented parapets are surmounted by bracketted cornices. Fifth-storey windows have blind arches. Main entry is centrally placed. Architectural style suggests construction date in late 1880's.

Eclectic, five-storey buildings of unpainted tan brick each four bays wide, surmounted by bracketted cornices. Fifth storey windows have blind arches. Main entries are centrally-placed, window lintels are of contrasting stone. Architectural style suggests late 1880's construction date.

820-826 Willow Avenue, vacant lots.

828,830 Willow Ave.

Two, three-storey Italianate buildings with high basements. Denticulated cornices; window heights survive intact, as do main entries. Lintels survive at #830; doorway lintels survive at both.

832-834 Willow Ave.

Classical Revival, six-storey buildings, four bays wide, stylistically unified. Denticulated, bracketted cornice, punctuated by consoles, below which brick piers divide the window bays. The piers are treated as pilasters, and are surmounted by Corinthian capitals. Each building is set off by quoins, which seem to have been removed on the corner building. #832 has a handsome door surround and lintels, supported by consoles, flanked by paired windows with similar enframements.

834 Willow Ave.

Ground floor entry, which may have matched that of #832, has been bricked in; all masonry ornamentation and window configurations have been insensitively altered.

Five-storey, half-block streets cape of Eclectic buildings, each four bays wide, with Classical Revival details. Bracketted cornices have Adamseque ornamentation on the fascia. Window lintels at the fifth and second stories have feature blind arches. Each building has intact, centrally-placed main doorways, surmounted by pediments. These entries are flanked by paired, rectangular windows with lintels. #801 (at corner) ground floor has been infilled in brick.




